

ADVENTURE FAMILY CAMPOREE

Camping Guidelines

Check-In: Begins on Friday at 1:00 p.m. and will close at 10 p.m. Campers arriving after that time will not be allowed to enter the regular camping area until Sabbath morning.

Registration: Directors only will register the club. Documents required are; Registrations forms, Payment for fees, copies of Permission to Treat forms for anyone under 18 years of age.

Items Not Allowed: No drugs, weapons, firearms, fireworks, alcohol, or tobacco products of any type are permitted on the Camp Yorktown Bay Camp Grounds.

Parents: Parents are *ALWAYS* required to be with and supervise their own children at all times. NO EXCEPTIONS.

Directors and Parents are responsible for ensuring the young people are following directions of the program. Please be on time and maintain a quiet and non-disruptive behavior during programs and other activities. Parents please model quiet and attentive behavior for their children. Clubs are requested to stay together as a unit as the program allows.

Personal Driving Vehicle: Personal driven vehicles will not be permitted in the camping area unless they are used as a storage and will not need to be moved during the family camp. There are designated parking spaces throughout the camp. Each club is required to camp as a unit and be respectful of the surrounding camps.

Camping: The Adventurer Family Camporee is intended to be a campout where the family unit can enjoy the outdoor camping and fellowship experience. Each club is required to camp as a unit and be respectful of the surrounding camps.

Dress Code: All clothing must be modest and free of offensive artwork or sayings. The Sabbath morning programs will be in full dress uniform. All other programs or activities will be in field uniforms such as club tee shirts, tennis shoes, etc.

Quiet Time: Quiet time is from 10:30 p.m. - 7:00 a.m. unless otherwise noted.

Loud Noise: Each club is to be respectful of the clubs surrounding them. Keep the loud noises down. No loud music, drums, etc. Except during designated times.

Fires: All campfires need to be in an above ground fire barrel covered with a screen. They also must have bricks or stones to keep the barrel off the ground. Fire is to be distinguished before leaving camp. Do not put hot coals or cinders on the campgrounds. Dispose of ashes in areas designated by the camp director.

Generators: Generators may be brought to the camp. Please observe quiet time from 10:30 p.m. to 7:00 a.m. unless otherwise noted. No generators running during this time.

Cooking: Each cooking area requires a fire suppression/extinguisher. Note: if campers are staying in a cabin, all cooking and food preparation must be performed outside. NO COOKING IN CABINS or LODGE.

Pets: No pets (cats, dogs, or otherwise) will be allowed on the grounds. We cannot be responsible for any injuries related to pets.

Drinking Water: Water may be obtained at the Maintenance Building, Cabins or exterior faucets of the cafeteria. Suggest you bring a wagon or cart to haul the containers of water or gray water.

Gray Water: Gray water (wash/dish cleaning water) is to be disposed of in designated areas of tanks provided.

Shower/Toilets: Showers and Toilets are provided in the bathhouses.

No personal ATV vehicles allowed at the camp. This includes: Six, four, and three wheelers, golf carts, etc. If it is not approved as an Arkansas Louisiana Conference Approved vehicle, then it is not allowed .

NO Bicycles, Skates, Skateboards or scooters of any type are permitted at the Adventurer Family Camp.

Bring your own chairs for your campsite. There may be times when they will be needed for some outdoor activities.

Weather: In case of bad weather everyone is to remain calm. Club director is to take roll of their club members and notify camp directors of any missing people. Relocate the club members to the camp cafeteria and stay together as a group for further instructions. Do not touch any live wires for any reason.

If a tornado should appear, relocate to the bathrooms of the cabins or cafeteria where there are interior walls. **Stay away from windows.** If you are outside drop to the ground lying face down in the lowest area possible, cover your head with your hands and wait for the bad weather to pass.

Patches: Adventurer Family Camporee patches will be provided for each registered attendee who has paid their registration fees. We do not have extra patches for souvenirs or non-registered attendees or friends.

Patch Distribution: Patches will be distributed to each club when their campsites or cabins are inspected by the area coordinators upon leaving the campground. Tent campsites are to be clean of trash. Cabins are to be swept out, trash removed, and bathrooms cleaned.
